- 1. **Praying For And With You.** Believing that you are important and believing in the power of prayer, your lay minister will join with the pastor and other lay ministers in praying for you and each member of your family.
- 2. **Visiting You.** The initial visit with you and your family will be at your home if permitted, or a neutral setting, such as the church, a restaurant, etc. The lay minister will also care for your immediate family members in times of sorrow, illness, and whenever else needed.
- 3. **Rejoicing.** Your lay minister will share in your joys when you celebrate important events or accomplishments in your life and the lives of your family members.
- 4. **Giving Support.** Sometimes your lay minister can help you through times of trouble by listening and giving moral and spiritual support. Other times your lay minister will help you to find someone else or a community agency that can help.
- 5. **Answering Questions.** Many people have questions about their faith, church, or denomination. Your lay minister will try to answer or find someone who can answer your questions.
- 6. **Connecting You.** Your lay minister will encourage you to attend events, so that you can meet other members for fun and fellowship. Your lay minister will remind you of events and meetings that will help you connect to the church ministry.
- 7. **Helping You Serve**. Your lay minister will help you find ways to serve in and through the church. Your lay minister will watch for opportunities for you to enhance and use the talents, skills, and abilities that God has given you.
